

U.S. universities are required by law to verify that students entering the United States with temporary student visas have adequate financial resources to meet the expenses of their program of study. You must satisfactorily complete this form in order to receive a Form I-20 from Bob Jones University, which you will use to apply for your student visa. All signatures and documentation provided must be originals and should be less than six months old. Be sure to include complete documentation for your source of funding.

\*If you are bringing more than one child, add an additional \$3,664 for each child.

There are two plans by which an international student may make financial arrangements to attend BJU.

### Method I

Complete the Financial Affidavit (on page 3) and provide one (1) original letter in English (or with an English translation) on official bank stationery from a bank or other financial institution showing that you possess the finances to cover all expenses. The specific amount of funds verified must total at least U.S. \$24,050, and the figure must be in U.S. dollars. (If there are additional family members coming with you, please refer to the chart above for the proper amount.) Before you can be accepted, you will need to pay in advance the entire amount of room, board, tuition and fees for one year, which amounts to U.S. \$18,520. If you withdraw voluntarily or by request of BJU, you will be refunded the unused portion of this advance payment.

### Method II

Secure a guarantor who will certify in writing to BJU that he or she will assume full financial responsibility for you for at least one full year. Payments may be made in person at the university Business Office, by mail with a check or money order, or through credit card by phone or online (more details are outlined in the university catalog). The total estimate for room, board, tuition, fees and living expenses for one full year is U.S. \$24,050. (If there are additional family members coming with you, please refer to the chart above for the proper amount.) If you withdraw voluntarily or by request of BJU, the guarantor will be responsible for all fees and a prorated amount of room, board and tuition.

Your guarantor must be a U.S. citizen residing in the U.S. and be approved by Bob Jones University to act as a guarantor.

**If you choose Method II, your guarantor must complete the Guarantor Form (page 2) in full, and you must complete the Financial Affidavit (page 3).**

6. Unless I notify BJU otherwise, I agree to assume the responsibilities for room, board, tuition and fees for each year the student is enrolled until the termination of his enrollment.

The guarantor must include with this form one (1) original letter on official bank stationery from a bank or other financial institution in which the sponsor has savings deposits, certificates of deposits, money market certificates or other types of accounts containing readily available funds. The letter must provide a specific amount of funds that the guarantor has available. If funds are in more than one financial institution, separate letters must be submitted from each.
