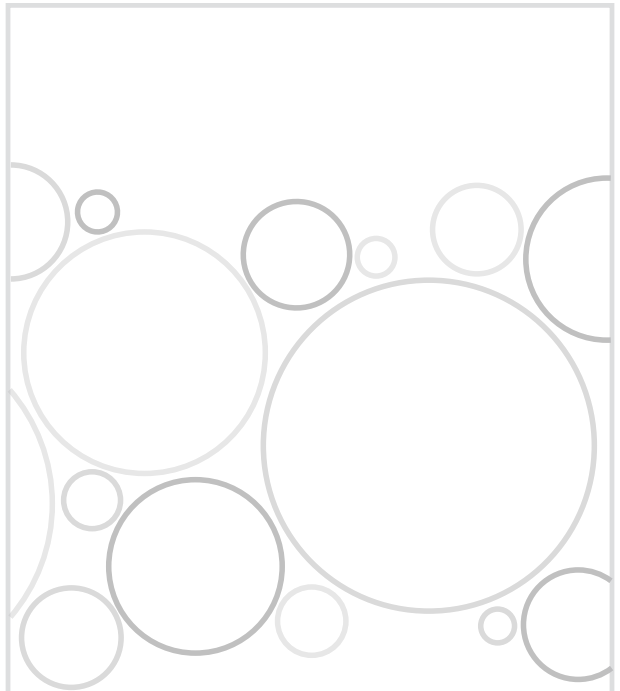

Summer School

What is it?

Bob Jones Academy summer school offers each student the opportunity to obtain high school credit and apply it toward the requirements for graduation. Summer school condenses the normal full-year's coursework for one subject into a six-week period. A student taking summer school will be able to take more elective courses during the high school years or may make up any lacking credits.

When is it?

The 2010 summer session begins at 7:30 a.m. on Monday, May 17, and concludes with exams on Friday, June 25. Classes will meet Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 12:20 p.m. Chapel (from 9:40 a.m. to 10:10 a.m. each day) is required of all students.

What can my child miss?

If you know that you have a conflict with the summer school schedule (such as a wedding to attend or a vacation planned), then summer school is not for you. Because summer school is extremely condensed, with one day equaling one week's worth of school-year work, a student may not be absent from a summer school class for any reason except illness.

What if my child drops the class?

A student who withdraws or drops a class after the third day of a summer school session will owe the registration fee and all of the tuition for the class.

What does it cost?

The cost for a day student taking one class in summer school is \$581. This includes a \$20 textbook fee, \$65 registration fee and \$496 for one unit of tuition. Room and board for resident students (rising 10th-12th graders only) is \$960 for the session. Tuition and fees are due at the Business Office the first day of classes.

How does my child register for summer school?

In mid-April, your child will be able to register on Academy Central for both a summer course and his/her fall courses. A parent will then need to log in to AcademyCentral to confirm the proposed courses by May 2.

What courses will be offered this summer?

See the reverse side of this form for courses that we plan to offer this summer. We anticipate being able to accommodate all students in either their first or second choice.

What should my child expect?

Students should plan to do homework and study for at least 4 hours daily for a summer school class. Most students should avoid weekday jobs or evening obligations (such as vacation Bible school) during summer school.
