
Dear Parents:

- A. Visit each of your student's classrooms in the order of his or her class schedule. The Library, Gym, Band, Chorus, Handbell and Orchestra Rooms will each be open for you to visit.
- B. In the Cafeteria – Sign up for Computer classes and Late Stay.
- C. In the Office – You may purchase, Scantrons, pay tuition and turn in your Emergency/Medical Information form.

JUNIOR HIGH LATE STAY POLICY 2009-10

Late Stay care is provided for children whose parents, because of work or other reasons, cannot pick them up immediately after school or school-related activities. Students not picked up by 3:10 and not under the supervision of their parents must check into Late Stay.

TIME: 3:10-5:30 p.m.

LOCATION: J.H. CAFETERIA

CHECK-IN TIMES:

1. 3:10 - unless a student is in a scheduled after-school activity.
2. 4:10 - for students staying after a scheduled after-school activity such as Band, Chorus, etc.
3. Students who check into Late Stay after 3:10 must have a pass from the office or the teacher who made them late. Those arriving after 3:10 (or 4:10 after an activity) without a pass will receive a tally.
4. Any student who enters the building after 3:10 must check in with the Late Stay supervisor. This includes students who stay to see a teacher.
5. Students may not check into Late Stay after having left the Junior High area.

CHECK-OUT:

1. A student may check out only if a parent or brother/sister comes for him or written permission is on file for him to walk to his parent's work place.
2. Pick-up: A parent may wait at the cafeteria entrance until the Late Stay worker sees the car and calls the student, or they may come in and get the student.

STUDY TIME: 3:30-4:00, 4:30-4:50

A supervised study hall is held in H-101 for those who need to do homework. Attendance in the study hall is not mandatory. Only students doing homework are allowed in H-101 during Late Stay.

SNACKS:

Snacks may be purchased from the snack room during Late Stay; however, all snacks must be kept in the Cafeteria unless the student is leaving the campus. Chewing gum is not permitted in Late Stay.

CHARGES for Late Stay:

1. The fee for Late Stay is \$4.00* per hour. If a student is not picked up by 5:30, \$6.00*/half hour will be charged. *Subject to change with notification.
2. Parents will be billed on the statement according to the times the student checks in and out.
3. If a student fails to check out, he will be charged through 5:30, which is the closing of late stay.

Faculty/Staff:

A full-time BJU employee who utilizes Late Stay for a tuition-benefited child while working will not be charged. He or she will be charged \$4.00/hour for utilizing Late Stay while not working. A full-time BJU employee who utilizes Late Stay for a non-tuition-benefited child will be charged a rate of \$2.00/hour while working or \$4.00/hour while not working. These policies apply whether or not the full-time employee's spouse is working at the time the child is in Late Stay.

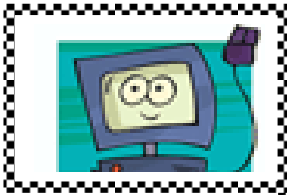

**Directions to the
Band, Chorus,
Handbell, Orchestra Rooms,
Library, LRC Room, and Gymnasium:**

1. Exit the west end of the Hutto Building go up the stairs immediately in front of you.
2. Follow the sidewalk until it dead-ends at the end of the Academy Brown Building.
3. For the **Band Room**, turn left and follow the sidewalk that goes between the Brown Building and Music Building B. Band meets in Music Building B.
4. For **Handbells**, turn right and follow the sidewalk as it curves around into a courtyard between the main part of the Brown Building and the back wing. There is a small wooden deck at the entrance to B108.
5. For **Orchestra, Chorus** and the **Gymnasium**, turn right and follow the sidewalk; you will see the Gymnasium ahead of you on your left. **Orchestra and Chorus** meet on the second floor of the Gymnasium; use the flight of stairs on the east outside wall of the Gym to reach the **Orchestra Room**; use the stairs in the center of the Gym to reach the **Chorus Room**.
6. For the **Library** and the **LRC** classroom, turn right and take the first left-hand sidewalk. You will notice two large windows facing you. Go to the right and just around the corner is the door leading into B-109.
