

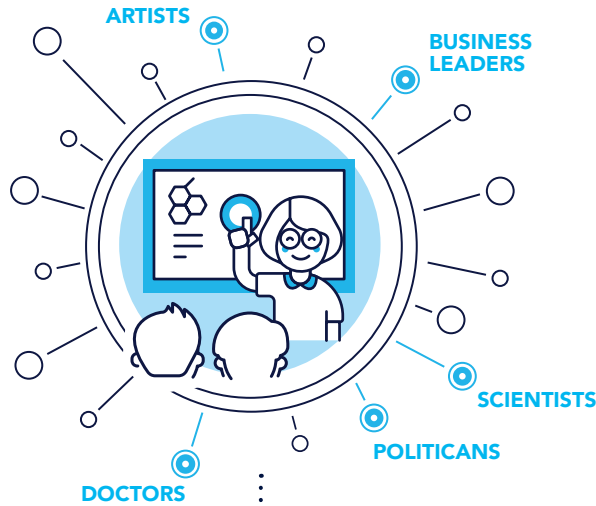


Christian Teachers are Influencers
